1. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Privacy Policy describes how ChalkWild, LLC (“we”, “us”, “our”), we collect, use and disclose information about users of our website (www.chalkwild.com), applications, services, tools and features (collectively, the “Services”). For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, “you” and “your” means you as the user of the Services. Please note that the Services are designed for users in the United States only and are not intended for users located outside the United States.

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By using any of the Services, you agree to the collection, use, and disclosure of your information as described in this Privacy Notice. If you do not agree to this Privacy Notice, please do not use or access the Services. If you have any questions or would like to discuss the contents of this policy further, please do not hesitate to contact us using the information below.

1. UPDATING THIS PRIVACY NOTICE

We may modify this Privacy Policy from time to time, in which case we will update the “Last Revised” date at the top of this Privacy Policy. If we make material changes to how we use or disclose information we collect, we will use reasonable efforts to notify you (for example by emailing you at the last email address you provided us, by posting notice of such changes on the Services, or by other means consistent with applicable law) and will take additional steps as required by applicable law. If you do not agree to any updates to this Privacy Notice, please do not continue using or accessing the Services.

2. OUR COLLECTION AND USE OF INFORMATION

When you use or access the Services, we may collect certain categories of information about you from a variety of sources.

Information Collected Directly From You

Some features of the Services may require you to directly provide certain information about yourself. You may elect not to provide this information, but doing so may prevent you from using or accessing these features. Information that you directly submit through our Services comprises of:

- **Basic contact details:** name, shipping address, phone number, email. We use this information to create and maintain your account, customize and ship products to you, provide the Services and to communicate with you (including about your order, and to tell you about products or services that may be of interest to you).
- **Any other information you choose to include in communications with us,** because it is in our legitimate interest to be responsive to you.

Information Collected Automatically

We may also use cookies or other tracking technologies, including Google Analytics, to automatically collect certain information about your interactions with the Services, which we use to run analytics and better understand interactions with our Services, for example, to understand how many individuals visit

our website. We may also use such information to tailor your experience and provide you with offers. . Such information comprises of:

- Device and browser information (such as device type, browser type, and IP address) and information regarding your interactions with the Services (such as data and time stamps, clickstream data, and log data)

Most browsers accept cookies automatically, but you may be able to control the way in which your devices permit the use of cookies. If you so choose, you may block or delete certain of our cookies from your browser; however, blocking or deleting cookies may cause some of the Services, including any portal features and general functionality, to work incorrectly. Your browser settings may also allow you to transmit a “Do Not Track” signal when you visit various websites. Information Collected From Other Sources

We may obtain information about you from other sources:

- Third party service providers who help us provide the Services (e.g., from our payment processor who collects certain payment information from you to complete transactions and help us provide you with product(s)).
- Third parties that you choose to share information with us through, for example when you choose to interact with us on social media (e.g., Facebook or Instagram) or other online services (e.g., Yelp), we will collect information about those interactions.
- Other sources, such as from publicly available sources.

In addition to the specific uses described above, we may use any of the above information to provide you with the Services and to maintain our business relationship, including enhancing the safety and security of our Services (e.g., troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, system maintenance, and reporting), providing customer support and payment processing, sending service, as well as offers and promotions, communications, complying with applicable legal obligations, enforcing any applicable terms of service, and protecting the Services, our rights, and the rights of our employees, users or other individuals.

3. OUR DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose your personal information to any of the following categories of third parties for legitimate purposes subject to this Privacy Notice:

- Vendors or other service providers who help us provide the Services, including for cloud storage, security, customer relationship management, email communications, web analytics, and payment processing.
- Professional advisors, (e.g. auditors, law firms, accounting firms, etc.).

- Third parties in connection with or anticipation of an asset sale, merger, bankruptcy, or other business transaction.

We may also disclose your information as needed to comply with applicable law or any obligations thereunder (including cooperation with law enforcement, judicial orders, and regulatory inquiries), to enforce any applicable terms of service, to ensure the safety and security of our business, employees, and users, in connection with or anticipation of an asset sale, merger, bankruptcy, or other business transaction, or when you request or direct us to disclose your information (including when needed to customize our products for you).

4. SOCIAL FEATURES

Certain features of the Services allow you to initiate interactions between the Services and third-party services or platforms, for example social networks (“**Social Features**”). Social Features include features that allow you to access our pages on third-party platforms, and from there “like” or “share” our content.
