## HOW TO TALK TO KIDS ABOUT THEIR ART

INSTEAD OF SAYING	TRY
What is it?	<b>Tell me about your artwork!</b> (Ask for kids to elaborate about their details instead of assuming their art has to "be" something)
It's so neat!	Your repeating lines/patterns really catch my eye! (Be specific with your comments)
That's a cool idea!	How did you do that? (Engage in a conversation with further questioning)
Put it on the fridge!	What would you like to do with your art? Do you want to give it to someone? Should we display it?  (Give students choice and ownership over what to do with their creation)
I love it!	How do you feel about it? Are you a proud artist?  (Instead of giving immediate affirmation, ask the kid to identify their feelings about their artwork first)
