## **RSK 4-6 L4 CONFLICT RESOLUTION COMIC STRIPS**

**Grade: 4-6** 

**Competency Area:** Relationship Skills

**Lesson Title: Conflict Resolution Comic Strip (Lesson #4)** 

<u>T-SEL Standard</u>: 4.F.2. Students practice acknowledging their role in a conflict, how others were hurt, what they could do differently in the future, and how to repair harm and move forward constructively.

**Duration**: 20 minutes

<u>Materials Needed</u>: ChalkWild erasable backpack + ChalkWild chalk markers + terry cloth

## Lesson Directions:

- 1. Introduction: Gather the students together. Ask students to raise a hand if they have ever experienced a conflict with a friend. Next, ask them how they were able to resolve the conflict. Invite several students to share aloud. Guide them to the key components of conflict resolution such as:
  - Staying calm
  - Using "I" statements
  - Finding a solution/compromise
- 2. Drawing Activity: "Conflict Resolution Comic Strip"
  - Provide each student with a copy of the Conflict Resolution Comic Strip worksheet.
  - o Instruct students to place the worksheet in their backpack.
  - Tell students to think of a time when they had a disagreement or conflict with a friend. Provide the following directions:
    - Panel 1: Draw a picture showing the conflict or problem.
    - Panel 2: Draw how they worked to solve or talk through the conflict.
    - Panel 3: Draw the compromise or outcome how they made things right.
- 3. **Sharing**: Invite several students to come to the front of the room and share their conflict resolution comic strips.
