



SOCA K-1 L5 ROUND-ROBIN OF KINDNESS

Grade: K-1

Competency Area: Social Awareness

Lesson Title: Round-Robin of Kindness (Lesson #5)

T-SEL Standard: 3.C.1 Students contribute to creating and maintaining shared agreements that guide their interactions with others and their environment. Students show kindness toward people of all backgrounds and experiences.

Duration: 20 minutes

Materials Needed: ChalkWild erasable backpack + ChalkWild chalk markers + terry cloth

Lesson Directions:

- 1. Introduction:** Begin by gathering the students in small groups. Ask them to think about all the different ways they can be kind to others, from saying thank you to sharing a toy. As students share aloud, write the list of kind actions down on the board or chart paper for the group to see.
- 2. Drawing Activity: "Round-Robin of Kindness."** Explain the activity: "**Today, you will work together to create a collaborative piece of kindness art.**"
 - Put students in small groups with one ChalkWild backpack in the middle.
 - Explain to the students that they will be creating a piece of group artwork. The first student draws one way they can show kindness to a friend, classmate, or family member.
 - Then the backpack is passed to the next student who draws a different act of kindness. The process continues until everyone in the group has contributed to the drawing.
- 3. Sharing and Discussion:** Once each group has completed their "kindness art," they will stand up and show it to the class. As a class, celebrate the many different ways we can show kindness and compassion. Instruct each student to write the phrase "**Be Kind**" on their own backpack and add a small symbol from their group work on kindness.
